MSME योजनाओं के द्वारा व्यवसाय का विकास



भारत में सूक्ष्म, लघु और मध्यम उद्योग (MSME) योजना के माध्यम से व्यवसाय के विकास के लिए सरकार कई तरह के लाभ, प्रोत्साहन और सहायता उपलब्ध करवा रही है। इन सभी सुविधाओं की एक व्यवसायी को अपने उद्योग को आगे बढ़ाने में महत्वपूर्ण भूमिका है। नीचे ऐसे तरीकों का विवरण दिया जा रहा है, जिन्हें अपना कर एक MSME व्यवसायी अपने उद्योग को तरक्की दे सकता है:

1. MSME के रूप में पंजीकरण : सबसे पहले तो आप अपने व्यवसाय या उद्योग का सरकार के उद्योग आधार पंजीकरण प्रक्रिया के तहत MSME के रूप में पंजीकरण करवाएं। एक बार MSME पंजीकरण करवा कर आप सरकार द्वारा इस क्षेत्र को उपलब्ध करवाई जा रही विभिन्न सुविधाओं और योजनाओं का लाभ पाने के लिए अधिकृत हो जाएंगे।

2. वित्तीय सहायता : इसके पश्चात आप MSME योजना के तहत उपलब्ध वित्तीय सहायता योजनाओं का अध्ययन करें और अपनी सुविधा और आवश्यकता के अनुसार उस योजना का लाभ लेने हेतु आवेदन करें। इनमें मुख्य रूप से सूक्ष्म और लघु उद्योगों के लिए क्रेडिट गारंटी फंड योजना (सीजीटीएमएसई) और प्रधानमंत्री रोजगार उत्पादन कार्यक्रम (पीएमईजीपी) जैसी योजनाएं हैं जो कि एक MSME व्यवसायी को अपना व्यापार स्थापित करने और उसे आगे बढ़ाने के लिए क्रेडिट सुविधा और अनुदान (सब्सिडी) प्रदान करती हैं।

3. अनुदान और प्रोत्साहन : MSME योजनाओं के अंतर्गत सरकार तकनीकी सुधार, कौशल विकास, प्रमोशन और निर्यात में वृद्धि के लिए कई तरह के अनुदान और प्रोत्साहन उपलब्ध करवाती है, जिनका लाभ उठाया जा सकता है। क्रेडिट लिंकड कैपिटल सब्सिडी योजना (सीएलसीएसएस) और टेक्नोलॉजी अपग्रेडेशन फंड योजना (टीयूएफएस) जैसी योजनाओं में उपलब्ध वित्तीय सुविधाओं का लाभ उठा कर एक MSME व्यवसायी अपने उत्पादन प्रणाली में आधुनिक तकनीकों को अपना कर अपने उत्पादन में बढ़ोतरी और सुधार कर सकता है और प्रतिस्पर्धा का सामना कर सकता है।

4. सरकारी खरीदारी : कई सरकारी विभाग और एजेंसियों में MSME उद्योगों से माल और सेवाओं की खरीद का लक्ष्य निर्धारित होता है, जो उन्हें पंजीकृत MSME क्षेत्र से आवश्यक रूप से खरीदारी कर पूरा करना

होता है। ये व्यवस्था पंजीकृत MSME के लिए व्यापार वृद्धि के अवसर प्रदान करती हैं। अतः सभी पंजीकृत MSME को इस सरकारी ई-खरीद हेतु डिजिटल पोर्टलों पर अपने व्यवसाय को पंजीकृत करना चाहिए और सरकारी खरीद में उपलब्ध अवसरों में सक्रिय भाग लेना चाहिए।

5. कौशल विकास कार्यक्रम : MSME क्षेत्र में कार्यरत कर्मचारियों के कौशल को बढ़ाने के लिए सरकार द्वारा कई कौशल विकास कार्यक्रमों का आयोजन किया जाता है। MSME व्यवसायियों को इन कार्यक्रमों का लाभ उठा कर अपने कर्मचारियों की कार्यकुशलता बढ़ानी चाहिए जिससे उत्पादकता में सुधार लाया जा सके। स्किल इंडिया मिशन जैसे कार्यक्रम इसी दिशा में एक प्रयास है जिसमें में भाग लेने से आपके व्यवसाय की उत्पादकता और कुशलता में सुधार किया जा सकता है और आप बाजार की प्रतिस्पर्धा का मुकाबला कर अपने व्यवसाय में वृद्धि कर सकते हैं।

6. निर्यात प्रोत्साहन योजनाएं : MSME उत्पादों के निर्यात के लिए सरकार द्वारा चलाई जा रही निर्यात संवर्धन योजनाओं और प्रोत्साहनों का लाभ उठा कर आप विदेशी बाजारों में संभावनाओं के नए द्वार खोल सकते हैं। निर्यात संवर्धन परिषदों (ईपीसी) और भारतीय निर्यात क्रेडिट गारंटी निगम (ईसीजीसी), जैसी योजनाओं का लाभ उठा कर आप अपने निर्यात को नई उचाईयों पर ले जा सकते हैं। ये योजनाएं MSME को विदेशी बाजारों में अपने निर्यात का विस्तार करने के लिए विदेशों में आयोजित होने वाले विभिन्न व्यापार मेलों, प्रदर्शनियों और प्रमोशन गतिविधियों में भाग लेने के लिए सहायता प्रदान करती हैं।

7. MSME संघों के साथ संपर्क : एक MSME व्यवसायी के रूप में आपका स्थानीय, क्षेत्रीय और राष्ट्रीय स्तरों पर MSME संघों और उद्योग संगठनों के साथ जुड़ाव अति आवश्यक है। अन्य MSME व्यवसायों के साथ संपर्क बनाने, व्यापार से संबंधित नई जानकारी प्राप्त करने, नवाचारों और संसाधनों तक पहुँच बनाने और अन्य आवश्यक सूचनाओं से अवगत रहने में यह जुड़ाव काफी मददगार साबित होगा। इन संघों द्वारा आयोजित विभिन्न आयोजनों, सेमिनार और वर्कशॉप में भाग ले कर आप अपने व्यवसाय में वृद्धि कर सकते हैं और नई व्यापारिक सम्बन्ध/साझेदारियां स्थापित कर सकते हैं।



8. अपना MSME पंजीकरण प्रचारित करें : एक MSME के रूप में आप अपने MSME पंजीकरण की स्थिति का आप अपनी व्यापार नीति में पूरा उपयोग करें। अपनी प्रमोशन सामग्री, व्यापार व्यवहार और उत्पाद की पैकेजिंग पर इसका स्पष्ट विवरण दें। MSME के साथ काम करने के फायदों, जैसे व्यक्तिगत सेवा, विक्रय पश्चात सेवा, शीघ्रता से उपलब्धता और स्थानीय उपस्थिति आदि जैसी विशेषताओं का विस्तार से विवरण दे कर आप ऐसे ग्राहकों को आकर्षित कर सकते हैं, जो लघु उद्योगों की महत्ता समझते हैं और उनका समर्थन करते हैं।

GUIDELINES OF PROCUREMENT AND MARKETING SUPPORT (PMS) SCHEME

1.0 INTRODUCTION:

Marketing, a strategic tool for business development, is critical for the growth and survival of MSMEs. Due to the lack of information, scarcity of resources and unorganized ways of selling /marketing, MSME sector often faces problems in exploring new markets and retaining the existing ones. Keeping in view these facts, the Procurement and Marketing Support Scheme has been introduced to enhance the marketability of products and services in the MSME sector.

2.0 THE SCHEME AIMS AT THE FOLLOWING:

- Promoting new market access initiatives like organizing / participation in National / International Trade Fairs / Exhibitions / MSME Expo, etc. held across the country.

- To create awareness and educate the MSMEs about importance / methods/ process of packaging in marketing, latest packaging technology, import-export policy and procedure, GeM portal, MSME Conclave, latest developments in international / national trade and other subjects / topics relevant for market access developments.

3.0 ELIGIBILITY CONDITION:

Manufacturing / Service sector MSEs having valid Udyam Registration (UR) Certificate.

4.0 IMPLEMENTING AGENCIES:

1. DC (MSME) through its field organizations namely MSME Development Institutes and Technology Centres.
2. Other field organizations of M/o MSME namely NSIC, KVIC, Coir Board
3. Other Central Govt. Ministries through their departments/ organizations/corporations/autonomous bodies and agencies
4. Departments / Organizations / Corporations / Autonomous bodies and Agencies of State Governments.

5.0 SCHEME COMPONENTS:

(I) Market Access Initiatives across the country:

(A) Participation of Individual MSEs in Trade Fairs / Exhibitions	
Eligible items	Scale of assistance
Space Rent charges	80% subsidy on built up space rent paid for General category units and 100% for SC/ST/women/ NER/ PH /Aspirational District units on minimum stall size of the event for Micro and Small Enterprises
Contingency expenditure (include travel, publicity & freight).	100% contingency expenditure for all categories of units subject to maximum Rs. 25,000/- or actual, whichever is less. One representative from each participating unit may travel, limited to AC II tier train fair/ Economy Class Air Fare per event.
Maximum Budgetary Support (including contingency expenditure)	Metro & A Class City: Rs 1.50 lakh (incl. All taxes) max or actual, whichever is less for a participating enterprise per event. Other City: Rs. 0.80 lakh (incl. All taxes) max or actual, whichever is less for a participating enterprise per event.
Note:	
i.	An MSE would be allowed reimbursement for maximum of 2 (two) events in a year.
ii.	Applicant units shall have to submit their claim online (or system in place) in the prescribed format within 30 days from date of conclusion of the event.
iii.	Overall participation in Min 100 Trade Fairs per year with Max 60 participating units per Trade Fair.
iv.	The Empowered Committee of the Scheme may assign an Implementing Agency which will represent the Ministry for propagating the scheme & policies in the event along with monitoring of participants and publicity by common fascia of the Ministry, hanging of bunting, etc. The budgetary support for participation of implementing agency will be max. 10% of total allocation to the event or actual whichever is less. The Implementing Agency will take the approval of the competent authority for detailed publicity proposal.

(BI Organizing Domestic/ International Trade Fairs/Exhibition and participation in trade fairs/exhibitions by the Ministry/Office of DC (MSME/Government organizations):

(a) The expenditure to be incurred wherever the Ministry decides to organize or participate on its own will be decided by the Empowered Committee, subject to the overall ceiling prescribed by the Deptt. of Expenditure (If applicable). The scale of assistance to participating MSEs in MSME pavilion will be admissible as detailed in space rent subsidy and contingency expenditure as above under para 5.0 (I)(A) above.
(b) Virtual Trade Fair: The upper cap for organizing / participating in Virtual Trade Fairs shall be Rs. 16.45 lakh or actual, whichever is less, towards the virtual platform cost, training and development cost and advertising & publicity cost. The minimum requirement for organizing a virtual trade fair should be on the basis of (i) Organizer's experience - 3 years (ii) Minimum number of sellers / exhibitors - 100 (iii) Minimum number of buyers / visitors - 1,000 (iv) Duration of fair - Min. 3 days (v) Timings- 8- 12 hrs interactive, 24 hrs live (vi) the platform should allow at least 20 products to be displayed and requisite digital space have to be allocated. Any other expenditure, if any, shall be borne by the event organizers.

(C)Vendor Development Program (VDP): To facilitate market linkages for effective implementation of Public Procurement Policy for MSEs.

(A) Adoption of Modern Packaging Techniques:

The upper cap for packaging interventions may be enhanced with approval of Empowered Committee subject to limit of max 10-15%.

(D) National Workshops / Seminars: To educate MSMEs on various facets of business development i.e. product & process development innovations, technological development, EXIM policy, Public Procurement Policy, adoption of e-commerce, design & packaging, market research and access. Scale of assistance: Rs. 5.0 lakh max. or actual, whichever is less per workshop / seminar, anywhere in the country. Assistance is admissible to the Govt. / Non - Govt. reputed organizations having at least 3 years of experience in organizing subject specific workshops / seminars.	
(E) Organizing National workshops/ Seminars by the Ministry / Office of DC (MSMEI (Conventional / Virtual): The expenditure to be incurred wherever the Ministry decides to organize or participate on its own will be decided by the Empowered Committee, subject to overall ceiling prescribed by the Deptt. of Expenditure, MoF (if applicable).	

(III) Development of Retail Outlet.

Item	Scale of assistance
Infrastructure development of Retail Outlets for promoting GI products	Rs. 30 lakh max per outlet in Metro & A class cities and Rs. 20 lakh max per outlets for other cities shall be provided towards infrastructure outlet area of 500 sq.ft with proper interior design, including computer, printer, bill counter, catalogue of product and show case to the retailer subject to 50% contribution from the retailer. Limit of GIA will be Rs. 15.0 lakh for Class A & Metro cities and Rs. 10.0 lakh for other cities, subject to matching contribution from the retailer. Only the products with valid Geographical Indications (GI) would be sold at such outlets. The seller must have an MoU / agreement with GI holder.
Implementing Agency	MSME-Development Institutes (MSME-DIs)
Mechanism	The Industry Associations / Trade Bodies representing the eligible retailers may submit their proposals to concerned MSME-DIs

6.0 Submission of Proposals: The proposal regarding the scheme components / events will be submitted to Implementing Agency on line (or system in place) well in advance preferably two months before the commencement of subject event.

7.0 Selection of MSEs: The Implementing Agency will send the proposals to Office of DC (MSME) online (or system in place), well in advance (preferably 45 days) prior to the



commencement of Trade Fairs / Exhibitions after due scrutiny of financial & physical viability and fulfillment of objectives of the event. The programme Division will submit the proposal to the Empowered Committee for the final approval. While processing the proposals, the preference shall be given to first time participants and units from remote location viz., from Aspirational Districts and also from SC/ST, Women, PH and NER. The Empowered Committee may also consider the post-facto approval for events which have been accorded Administrative Approval but could not be placed for approval of Empowered Committee before commencement.



8.0 Empowered Committee: The Empowered Committee shall be the final authority for approval of proposals. The Empowered Committee will be headed by Secretary / AS & DC (MSME) with JS (SME) or his / her representative, ADC (PMS) / In-charge of PMS Division, Director (Planning and Marketing)



NSIC or his/her representative and Nominee of IFW as members. Secretariat services shall be provided by PMS Division of Office of DC (MSME). Any of the Export promotion Association / Industry association may be invited as special invitee (optional) to attend the meeting, if needed. AS & DC (MSME) / ADC (PMS) may relax the criteria of minimum applications per implementing agency for events under 5(A) for specific events depending on urgency and other such circumstances. ADC (PMS) can give in-principle administrative approvals for the events proposed under the PMS scheme.

9.0 The scheme will be monitored through an integrated MIS by the Implementing Agency and also scheme management unit setup in the office of DC (MSME).

10.0 It is to be ensured that every event is led by business and data for each event along with participants has to be captured for follow up action and also to do performance audit. The Outcome for various programmes including Trade Fairs and Vendor Development Programmes should invariably include the parameters as specified in Output/Outcome framework of NITIAAYOG.

11.0 Services of Professional / Event Management Agencies / Organizations may be utilized as per GFR for organizing events for Ministry / Government.

An Interview with Derek Miller

What is your view about the current kitchenware and housewares market in the US and globally?

Coming out of Covid when the kitchenware and housewares market had record sales in the US, retailers and suppliers had a decline in year-over-year sales – it was almost impossible to maintain the historically high levels. The industry over the past year has started to stabilize – Circana, a U.S.-based research company presented at the 2024 Show that overall sales for the small appliance and housewares segment was down 3.5% in 2024, is forecasted to be flat in 2025 and up 3.4% in 2026. All of that said, small appliances and housewares remain one of the only general merchandise industries above 2019 levels.

Could you describe the changes you made in 2024 the show as compared to 2023?

The IHA board of directors continues to listen closely to the needs of the industry. With the feedback regarding reduced budgets and new time constraints after the Pandemic, we made several changes to create the most productive trade show experience possible. The 2024 Show was three full days, Sunday through Tuesday, and the three main expos – Dine + Décor, Clean + Contain and Wired + Well – were located within the two main halls of McCormick Place. This new format created a trade show experience that was more productive and highly efficient. Based on the feedback from the 2024 Show, the new layout and format were very well received by both exhibitors and buyers.

Why did you change the show from 4 days to 3 days?

Through exhibitor & attendee surveys and direct meetings with our Retail Advisory Councils, the Exhibitor Trade Show Advisory Committee and the IHA

Board of Directors, the overall consensus from the industry was that three full days at the Show is a sufficient amount time to conduct meetings to have a successful experience. As said, our goal is to create the most efficient and productive marketplace possible, and shortening of the Show helps reduce costs for both exhibitors and attendees who now have slightly shorter stays in Chicago.

How many total exhibitors and visitors as compared to last year?

The Show featured 1,648 exhibitors from 38 countries. Nearly 30,000 home + housewares professionals from over 120 countries came together to discover new products, connect with colleagues and advance the industry.

How many new exhibitors and visitors in 2024 show?

There were over 400 first-time and returning companies, including more than 100 well-known brands that were back after an absence. These companies included Artland, BergHOFF, BSH Bosch, Cool Gear, Corkcicle, Cuisinart, Emile Henry, Fissler, J.K. Adams, Everplush-Tricol Clean, Jean Dubost, Joseph Joseph, Keurig/Dr. Pepper, Lotus Sustainable, Midea, Opinel, Range Kleen, Scan Pan, StolzeLausitz Glassware, Tramontina, and Zwilling J.A. Henckels, to name a few.

On the attendee side, the analysis on new visitors hasn't been made yet.

How was the overall response for the 2024 Show?

During the Show, the IHA team meets with hundreds of exhibitors and buyers as well as with our three Retail-specific Advisory Councils. The overall reaction to the 2024 Show has been very positive with exhibitors stating that they were able to meet with key retailers from both the U.S. and abroad, and buyers stating

that they were able to find new brands that featured innovative products.

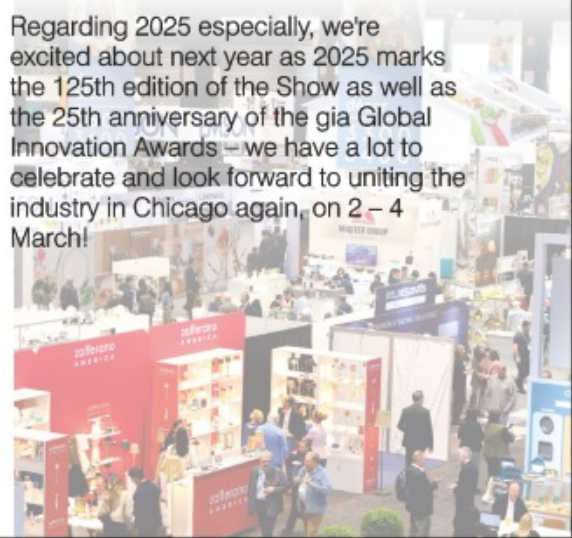
What was the best thing about The Inspired Home Show 2024?

The alkaline bipolarelectrolyser, which has a capacity of 350 Nm³/hr, guarantees on an average 90Nm³/hr round-the-clock supply of green hydrogen using dedicated solar energy and storage. The facility aims at abating around 54,000 tonnes of CO₂ emissions over 20 years and is based on a long-term off-take agreement. The facility is controlled by an advanced energy management and control system and Hygenco is operating the plant under Build-Own-Operate (BOO) model. The first commercial-scale green hydrogen plant, powered by rooftop and floating solar, was completed within the stipulated time frame.

The facility has a comprehensive monitoring system to track hydrogen generation, renewable energy generation, states of charge, pressure, and temperature. It can make real-time decisions to achieve high efficiency. Hygenco's technology augments hydrogen yield and delivers cost-competitive hydrogen.

India, which is majorly dependent on imports for its energy needs, announced the National Green Hydrogen Mission last year. The Mission envisages the production of five million tonnes of green hydrogen by 2030.

Oryx says its recycling activities improving Thailand's environment

Stainless steel recycler says use of scrap in the region reduces carbon emissions equivalent to emissions in an entire district in Thailand.

Netherlands-based metals recycling company Oryx Stainless, which also has operations in Thailand, says a study it commissioned shows that increased recycling of stainless steel "can make a noticeable contribution to mitigate climate change in Thailand and globally."

The study was conducted by Thai and German scientists on behalf of Oryx Stainless (Thailand) Co. Ltd., along with The Fraunhofer Center for International Management and Knowledge Economy IMW from Leipzig, Germany. The effort also was supported by the German Embassy in Thailand, according to Oryx.

Oryx says the study examined the social welfare benefits of recycling stainless steel in Thailand. "For every ton of stainless steel scrap used to produce new stainless steel, 6.71 tons of CO₂ are saved compared to the use of primary raw materials," says Oryx.

Based on the stainless steel scrap handled by Oryx Stainless in Thailand in 2021 (used as the reference year in the study), the scientists calculated CO₂ savings of 556,000 tons. This approximately corresponds to the annual carbon footprint of the residents of the Muang Chachoengsao district near an Oryx Stainless plant in Thailand.

That emissions tonnage figure also equates to 1.45 percent of the total greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions from all industrial processes Thailand in 2021, according to the researchers.

"The potential for Thailand and the climate becomes clear when one sees that almost 3.6 million tons of CO₂ were saved within the entire Oryx Stainless Group in the reference year," states the recycling company.

"This study shows that the smart use of recycling raw materials such as stainless steel scrap and their use in the production of new products can make a tangible contribution to the fight against climate change," says Sirichai Tempoomsuk, the chief financial officer (CFO) of Oryx Stainless Thailand.

"Stainless steel scrap is a particularly valuable secondary raw material due to its very high recyclability," continues the CFO. "Stainless steel can be recycled without any loss of quality. Worldwide, 95 percent of stainless steel is recycled at the end of its lifespan [and] 70 percent is recycled as stainless steel."

Adds Tempoomsuk, "Scrap currently accounts for around 48 percent of raw materials for stainless steel production worldwide. In Europe, leading stainless steel producers go to

the limits of what is technically feasible and use up to 95 percent secondary raw material blends for the production of new stainless steel."

Oryx says the effects of climate change are of particular importance to Thailand, with the country ranking ninth in a global long-term climate change risk index calculated by Germany-based think tank Germanwatch.

In terms of the economic savings of recycling, the volume of stainless steel scrap Oryx puts back into the production cycle in Thailand prevented about \$52 million of spending on ores and mining, according to the study.

The calculation is based on the "Scrap Bonus" indicator developed by the Fraunhofer Center, which involves two steps. In the first step, the environmental impact avoided by using one ton of stainless steel scrap in steel production is quantified. In the second step, various economic estimates and price references from emissions trading systems are used to convert the avoided environmental impact into a currency value. "In other words, a price is assigned to the (avoided) pollution," says Oryx.

Oryx says 7.79 million tons of stainless steel was produced in Asia in 2023 (excluding China and South Korea), with Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) countries including Malaysia and Indonesia "building up millions of tons of new capacity."

Thailand produced around 366,000 tons of stainless steel in 2022 and is the second largest consumer of stainless steel in the ASEAN region, says the recycling firm.

"The growth perspective in Southeast Asia and thus in Thailand underlines the need for the smart use of our resources in view of the ongoing climate change caused by the emission of greenhouse gases," says Christian Klöppelt, a research fellow at the Fraunhofer Center.

He adds, "This is where politics is needed, also in Thailand. Smart recycling creates both economic and environmental benefits for Thai society. To take full advantage of these benefits, policy makers should ensure a level playing field for raw materials and provide favorable operating conditions for the recycling industry."

The researchers propose a system of pricing tied to CO₂ emissions in Thailand. "Additionally, there's a suggestion to expand the Thai Bio-Circular-Green (BCG) Economy Model to include metal scrap," add the scientists. They also recommend "creating conducive operating conditions for the recycling industry."

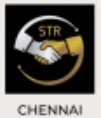
